Products Affected: All Hemisphere GNSS Atlas-capable receivers

Scope:

Effective May 31, 2018, the following new Atlas transmission frequencies **will replace** all currently in-use Atlas frequencies.

Hemisphere GNSS Atlas-capable receivers will require an upgrade to Athena firmware version 5.9.Aa05 to continue using the Atlas global correction service.

Receivers not upgraded to firmware version 5.9.Aa05 or higher will require manual tuning to the new Atlas frequencies via the \$JFREQ command.

The change affects the following correction services:

- Atlas Basic
- Atlas H30
- Atlas H10
- Atlas H100 (Replaced by Atlas Basic)



The new Atlas broadcast frequencies are outlined below:

| Region | Current Frequency | New Frequency |
|----------|-------------------|---------------|
| Americas | 1545.5300 MHz | 1545.915 MHz |
| APAC | 1539.8525 MHz | 1545.855 MHz |
| EURO | 1540.9525 MHz | 1545.905 MHz |
